Bonaire WebCams

Too cold to dive where you live? Weather got you down? Yearning for the warmth and clarity of Caribbean waters? Then join the over 2,000 people who visit the Bonaire WebCams daily at <http://www.BonaireWebCams.com>!

Operating steadily for over two years (our preview site launched in March of 2000, and we officially went live in August 2000), the Bonaire Web Cams site features live images and weather from the Caribbean Diver's Paradise of Bonaire, featuring the world's only permanently installed underwater WebCam – the Bonaire ReefCam. Fish, octopi, and divers visit the ReefCam daily. In fact a day rarely goes by where divers are not seen live on our site.

The ReefCam is installed at the Small Wall dive site on Bonaire, with permission of the Bonaire National Marine Park, only 150 feet from shore but already in amongst the coral heads. Dive boat occupants regularly request dives at the site so that their friends back home in North America, Europe, or wherever they hail from, can see them underwater.

Popular with those yearning for Caribbean sunsets are our ever-present BeachCams, which together provide a 160 degree view of the western horizon.

For those who want to show up on the Cams without getting wet, there's the near cult-status Bonaire StreetCam, located in front of the house which plays home to the WebCam capture center.



A whole community of on-line Bonaire WebCams fans has sprung up at www.BonaireTalk.com - images are regularly captured from the WebCams site by avid Cam fans, and posted on BonaireTalk for commentary, joint appreciation, and even simple destination envy.

All camera images are updated every 2 minutes, and operate 24 hours a day (although at night there's not much to see – it's dark, you know). Captured images and weather information are transferred from the capture servers on Bonaire to dedicated Web servers in Massachusetts from where the latest images, underwater temperature information, and live weather stats are made available to the rest of the world!

We've even maintained complete archives (of all non-dark images) since December 1, 2000. These archives are available to anyone who is willing to make a nominal financial contribution to help support on-going maintenance and R&D of the Bonaire WebCams effort. Paying members can also send ePostCards of any WebCam image to anyone they wish, whether it be a cool fish they caught on the 'Cams, or images of themselves from a recent vacation to Bonaire. The perfect Bonaire electronic on-line memento!
